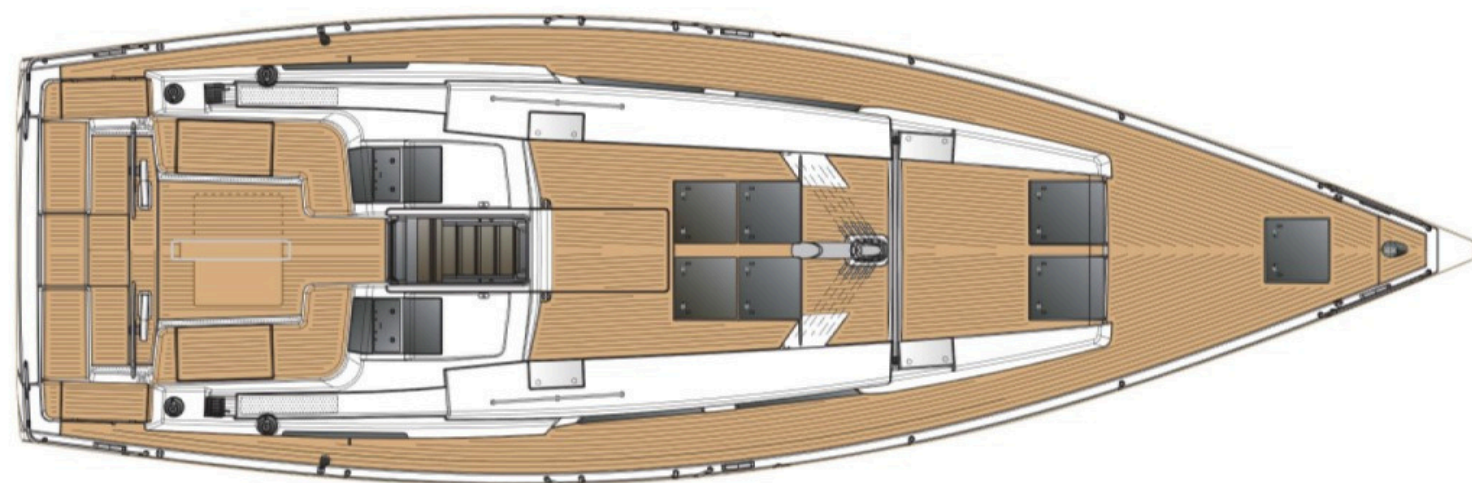

### **Accommodation:**
