

Technical characteristics

SUNNYACHT is a sailing catamaran built in Gdansk, Poland, by the shipyard SUNREEF. It measures 18.90 meters in length and 9.20 meters in width, with a draft of 1.55 meters.

It was launched in December 2008 and is equipped for offshore and MCA (Maritime and Coastguard Agency) use.

Its sails and rigging include a carbon mast without spreaders and a carbon canoe boom.

The sails are made of Hydranet fabric: a 118m² mainsail, a 63m² genoa, a 32m² solent, and a 120m² gennaker on a furler.

SUNNYACHT is powered by 2 inboard engines (2 x 110hp) with a total fuel capacity of 1800L and features 2 bow thrusters.

Its electronic equipment includes a Raymarine navigation system, chartplotter, speed log, depth sounder, radar, GPS, AIS, autopilot, VHF, BLU, and Navtex.

Onboard equipment includes:

A 17 kW generator,

6 solar panels with a total capacity of 1600 W,

2 water desalinators (1 SEARECOVERY 220L/hour and 1 AQUABASE 105L/hour) with a water tank capacity of 800L,

6 LED underwater lights,

automatic life jackets,

and a 4.20m long dinghy with a 50hp engine, essential for reaching the shore and exploring the surroundings on land.

For water activities, SUNNYACHT offers:

1 two-seater kayak,

2 stand-up paddles,

2 windsurfers,

Towed buoy,

Wakeboard and water skiing equipment,

Snorkeling gear for exploring underwater with mask/snorkel/fins,

Fishing equipment.

Indoor comfort

Spacious and filled with daylight, the main living area features clearly defined spaces: a lounge area, a dining table for 8 guests, an open kitchen, and a navigation table.

The quality of materials and natural light creates a cozy, elegant, and luxurious ambiance. In the evening, ambient lighting provides a peaceful glow.

All windows are equipped with electric blackout blinds.

High-end "multisource-multiroom" audio-video system


Each cabin is equipped with a TV, a DVD player, and a Chromecast

Additionally, there is an outdoor barbecue

Sunnyacht accommodates comfortably 6 guests

- 1 master cabin with a 160 x 200cm bed, plus a desk space
- 1 double cabin with a 160 x 200cm bed
- 1 double cabin with a 140 x 200cm bed

Each cabin has a private bathroom with a shower, sink, and electric freshwater toilet.













Outdoor comfort

SUNNYACHT's entire deck is covered in teak, and the deck panels are flush. You can enjoy its numerous spaces:

On the cockpit, a covered terrace extending from the main living area: teak table, director's chairs, benches, and two large loungers on each side.

At the front, trampolines equipped with custom cushions for maximum comfort during relaxation and sunbathing.

On the flybridge, a teak table, benches, and sunbed cushions to enjoy a 360° view.

Its varied spaces, whether intimate or more expansive, encourage moments of relaxation or socialising with family or friends, whether to savour a cocktail together or to share a delicious musical dinner.
