





Queen of Datca was designed as a true sailing yacht in the shape of a traditional Turkish gulet, combining elegance and performance. Her sailing equipment is of the highest specification with 1000 sq. metres of sails.

She is extremely well equipped to provide you comfort. As you'd expect from a 36m gulet, there is ample deck space with a large seating/lounge area, lots of comfort zones with cushions and sun beds, spacious interiors including a large saloon equipped with satellite TV, entertainment systems and a wide range of water toys. One or two of the crew cabins located aft can be also converted to children / nanny cabin(s) in case of personal use with 4 or 5 crew members.)




















































